Strategic Review and the Integration Process of National Students Union Participation.


This is all overseen by a total quality management via project structures and meetings and daily project management.

#### **ATTAINED RESULTS**

#### 1. PILOTING 1, EVALUATION OF PILOTING 1

Due to the pandemic, pilot 1 was carried out only in Kazakhstan:

Pilot 1 at the al-Farabi Kazakh National University

- Dates: 3-4 February, 2020
- Event: Pilot 1 at the al-Farabi Kazakh National University DECIDE Pilot 1 Observation
- Place: Faculty of Medicine and Health Care, al-Farabi Kazakh National University, Almaty, Kazakhstan

#### **Description of event:**

Coordinator of the DECIDE project Angela Repanovici from UTBV (Romania) and Director of the Library Manolis Koukourakis from UOC (Greece) visited al-Farabi Kazakh National University as observers from EU universities of Pilot 1.

According to the plan of DECIDE project implementation, on February 3-4, 2020 al-Farabi Kazakh National University conducted classes on Module 2 and Module 4 for teaching and administrative staff of the university, librarians, students and people from other relevant organizations in the frameworks of Pilot 1.

The Module 2 and Module 4 were developed by project team of the university in collaboration with colleagues from Tajikistan and Uzbekistan. Prior to work on Modules participants of the DECIDE project attended trainings in Dresden (TUD) and Limerick (LIT). These trainings at TUD and LIT were delivered by the EU partners of the project and included: purpose, rationale and content of the DECIDE curriculum to include international Quality Standards and the requirements of international, Bologna agreement and ECTS Modular creation using the EU-TUNING system.

In Limerick training was followed by DECIDE workshops to enable all partners to explore how modules 2-8 can be designed and adapted for different target groups (University library and academic staff, National and Public Libraries etc.).

The Module 2 is elaborated for wide range of specialists working in academic, governmental, and non-governmental sectors to provide knowledge and skills in marketing theory and practice for organization of National Awareness Day in all three countries.

Module 4 is Access Liaison Officer Trainee Programme. It is targeted at all partners with inputs from all partners and the basis of the future Action Group. This training module was developed to that each educational organization will have a specialized person in social integration and anti-discrimination measures on advising and assisting students or potential students with special needs in accessing education.

Module 2 training was conducted on February 3, 2020 at the Faculty of Medicine and Health Care and gathered academic and administrative staff, including stakeholders who provide assistance in social protection of students with different types of needs. The Module was presented by Dr. Gainel Ussatayeva, who as an Acting Associate Professor of the Department of Epidemiology, Biostatistics and Evidence-based

Medicine. She provided plan and purpose of the Module 2 to organize national Awareness Day, main terms, theory and ways of practical implication.

Module 4 training was conducted next day, on February 4, 2020 also at the Faculty of Medicine and Health Care by Guldana Ispambetova, lecturer from the Department of Physical Education and Sport . Her topic covered issues related to provision of physical activity to the students with special needs in the frameworks of Module 4.

#### 3. NATIONAL AWARNESS DAY

All events were online, ZOOM meetings, agenda and reports were provided.

The Kazakhstan National Disability Awareness Day (NAD) held between October 5 and October 16, 2020 within Erasmus+ project "Developing Services for Individuals with Disabilities" – DECIDE

Kazakhstan was the first country to hold its DECIDE project NAD. For the first time in the Republic of Kazakhstan, the National Disability Awareness Day (hereinafter – NAD) was organized and held on October 8-9, 2020 on relevant issues of inclusion in accordance with the implementation of the international EU ERASMUS + project 598661 "DECIDE" (Developing services for individuals with disabilities). S. Seifullin Kazakh Agro Technical University in Nur-Sultan (hereinafter – KATU) was the main organizer, together with working groups of partner universities: Kazakh National University named after Al-Farabi (Almaty, Kazakhstan), A. Baitursynov Kostanay Regional University (Kostanay, Kazakhstan), Academy of Public Administration under the President of the Republic of Kazakhstan (Nur-Sultan, Kazakhstan). The Kazakh NAD event slogan used was "We are different, We are equal, We are together."

The main focal event of the Kazakh NAD was the Zoom conference attended by 116 participants, 30 speakers, including representatives of the Ministry of labor and social protection of the population of the Republic of Kazakhstan, Ministry of Health of the Republic of Kazakhstan, Ministry of Agriculture of the Republic of Kazakhstan, EASEA - Erasmus + Agency (Brussels), Director of the National Office of the Erasmus + Program in Kazakhstan, leader of the DECIDE project (Romania), rectors of universities - executors of the DECIDE project, civil servants, representatives of business structures, PhD, master and bachelor students of universities of the Republic of Kazakhstan, 10 representatives of NGOs (non-governmental organizations) and communities of people with disabilities from 3 foreign countries, as well as 10 foreign partners of the DECIDE project from 7 countries around the world.

A multiplicity of activities took place in addition to, and accompanying the main ZOOM conference event run by KATU. The main ones were:

- 1 Virtual information exhibition
- 2. A poster competition
- 3. Online training event for teachers in context of inclusive education
- 4. Essay competition
- 5. Inclusivity awareness campaign in the Kostanay region over ten-day period with wide reach of over 120 000 in schools from kindergarten, secondary to HEIs.
- 6. Online Discussion Forum
- 7. Lead-up events for civil servants including sign language training for communication with hearing impaired persons.
- 8. Coaching event for parents of disabled children.

### THE NATIONAL AWARENESS DAY IN TAJIKISTAN (November 18, 2020)

The Tadjik NAD, which took place on 18th November 2020 under the main umbrella motto "We are all differently disabled people", was also a very successful event with over over 70 participants. Accompanying events to the main presentations (of which there were 11, and which included guest presentations from international partners in Uzbekistan and Kazakhstan) were also poster and essay competitions among students, and inspiring success stories of disabled students.

#### National Awareness Day (NAD) in Uzbekistan

On November 24, 2020 in Uzbekistan the National Awareness Day (NAD) was held on current issues of inclusive education in accordance with the international project "DECIDE" (Development of services for people with disabilities) of the European Union's DECIDE Erasmus+ programme, under the slogan "A strong Man will not Fall".

Over 128 members from vary regions and institutions of the Republic of Uzbekistan took part in the NAD event, additionally with international guests from European programme partner countries.

In the online event more 24 members participated with their presentations and discussed issues related to the creation of socially favorable conditions for people with disabilities in Uzbekistan, barriers and opportunities in inclusive higher education, the rights and lifestyles of people with disabilities.

Moreover, the process of conducting the NAD, and outcomes of the NAD were distributed in the mass media by My Country TV channel **(MY5)** in Uzbekistan, and they have been uploaded on the site of Tashkent University of Information Technologies named after Muhammad al-Khwarizmi.

#### **OVERALL**

All three NADs of partner countries presented in Russian and/ or local languages and in English, with translations in English through interpreters, or vice versa. This enabled wider accessibility for the wider international audience.

All NADs included real-life experience reports from disabled persons, highlighting the direct impact and relevance of project activities for those for whom the project is designed to benefit, fulfilling the aim of wider social inclusivity in higher and further education of the disadvantaged in the respective country education systems.

Inputs from NGO partners in the the NADs were also most relevant to the greater accessibility for the disadvantaged in the respective education systems, and as a result the enhancement of the greater inclusion and involvement in society, and as a result, the respective social and national progress and development in all three central Asian partner countries.

This first round of NADs in all partner countries successfully established the basis for expansion and extension of the DECIDE project in its continuation.







#### **EXPECTATIONS FROM THE DECIDE PROJECT ONLINE PLATFORM**

We analysed the results obtained through the questionnaire on expectations from DECIDE Project online platform and concluded that 76.47% of all respondents consider that additional training is needed through online training courses.

The main aspects to be improved in the respondents' own activity are the following:

- 1. Additional training is needed to teach online to students with disabilities 82,35%
- 2. Preparation of summative online assessment activities 58,82%
- 3. Preparation of activities to correct students' products and how to calculate grades 41,06%

Also, the respondents of the study consider that for the social inclusion of students with disabilities it is important to know:

- Psychological profile of students with disabilities 50%
- Practices in communicating with students with disabilities 57.14%
- Practices in electronic communication with students with disabilities 50.00%
- Pedagogical methods in the interaction with people with disabilities 28.57%
- Social inclusion of people with disabilities 60.00%
  - Strategies for creating online teaching materials for students with hearing and vision impairments 37, 50%

These results allow the issuance of the recommendation to continue the training of the participants in the DECIDE project, especially regarding the aspects stated above.
